Administration: A Bibliography on Historical Organization Practices, Vol. 5, edited by Frederick L. Rath, Jr. and Merrilyn Rogers O'Connell. (Nashville: American Association for State & Local History, 1980. 228 pp., index, \$14.95.)

In this, the largest volume to date, the editors deal with virtually every aspect of administration of historical/cultural institutions, citing more than 2,400 sources in an annotated guide. Subjects include fund raising, management, taxes, law, insurance, governing boards, personnel practices, public relations, physical security, membership development, etc. A complete index aids easy access to the subject matter. Administrators of historical societies at the local, county, state, and national levels will want this reference guide on their desks.
