

## Recent Reprints

Several of our largest regional publishers, as well as many national ones, have chosen to emphasize reprints of significant historical and literary works in their publication programs. Such reprints reintroduce valuable classics, often with new accompanying interpretation or background information. Yet rarely will they receive scholarly review because book review editors assume most scholars' previous familiarity with the original works. The *Annals of Iowa* will review those reprints of particular relevance to Iowa history or with major revisions and additions, but will also now regularly notice those other reprints which may be of special interest to historians of Iowa and the Midwest.
