Bibliography of Iowa History, 1981-1982

This bibliography is a listing of works on Iowa published in 1981 and 1982. If I have used the term "history" in the title too loosely, the intent was to err on the side of being inclusive rather than exclusive. For example, while an article on the contemporary Iowa State Fair may not be strictly historical, it may still be of great interest to Iowa readers and researchers. I have tried to list all the significant items I could find and I regret the inevitable omissions of those items which were not discovered. Annotations are given with those items whose titles do not sufficiently reveal the subject matter.

I would like to thank David Hudson and Earl Rogers of the University of Iowa and James Leonardo of Drake University for supplying me with some of the entries. The bibliography follows the subject arrangement which David Hudson and I devised for a larger work—a bibliography of Iowa history covering the years 1952 to 1980—which we hope will be published soon. This arrangement is an adaptation of that used by William J. Petersen in his earlier work, Iowa History Reference Guide, (Iowa City, 1952).
