HISTORICAL ACTIVITIES

The Historical Society of Western Pennsylvania sponsored a motor tour on June 28, 1947. The trip included a visit to Grove City College and a stop at Harmony, site of the first Harmonite settlement in this country.

The Forest Products History Foundation of the Minnesota Historical Society is interested in locating unpublished diaries, letters, and business papers relating to logging, lumbering, and the industries dealing with forest products of all kinds.

The collection of Lincoln papers donated to the Library of Congress by Robert T. Lincoln in January, 1923, on condition they were not to be made public until twenty-one years after his death, were opened for reference on July 26, 1947. There are 18,350 items in the collection, chiefly letters to Lincoln.

IOWA

The Pocahontas County Historical Society is making a collection of the pictures of women of the county who were enrolled in the armed forces in World War II.

The Wayne County Historical Society has made plans to mark the sites of "ghost" towns in that county. Pearl W. McMurry is president, Roy Grimes, secretary, and W. H. Burton, curator.

The State Department of History and Archives at Des Moines is making a collection of the records and photographs of some 300,000 Iowa men and women who served in World War II.

The Wyoming Historical Society held its annual meeting on August 26, 1947. The president, Mrs. John Morse, gave a brief history of the founding of the society. The theme of the program was "post offices of pioneer days".

F. E. Frisbee of Sheldon was elected president of the O'Brien

County Historical Society at the annual meeting held on August 27, 1947, at Primghar. Other officers include Mrs. O. H. Montzheimer of Primghar, vice president, and Mrs. I. L. Church of Sheldon, secretary.

The Union County Historical Society held its annual meeting at Creston on October 1, 1947. E. L. Carroll gave a talk on the necessity of preserving historical records and L. C. Bowers told the story of a shawl once owned by Mrs. Abraham Lincoln, now owned by the Union County Historical Society. Ray Wilson was elected president for the ensuing year. Other officers re-elected were: Mrs. Blanche Erikson of Lorimor, vice president; Ella M. Day of Creston, secretary; George Hall, treasurer; and Grace B. Harsh, historian.

The Chicago and North Western Railway System is sponsoring a contest to locate historical material in preparation for its centennial celebration in 1948. Cash prizes will be awarded to the local historical societies furnishing the most interesting historical items such as anecdotes and such old papers as an old timetable, poster, or dining car menu. Among the Iowa societies which have announced their intention of entering the contest are the Marshall County Historical Society, the Plymouth County Historical Society, the Tama County Historical Society, the Pottawattamie County Historical Society, the Hamilton County Historical Society, and the Cerro Gordo County Historical Society.
