The IJLS is a journal of artistic endeavor and critical inquiry managed and edited by graduate students at The University of Iowa. We publish the work of those currently or recently enrolled in graduate programs here. We publish one issue annually, and we accept submissions from July through January of each year. The cost per copy is \$4.00 (plus .50 for postage).

To submit work, please send *two clean copies* of your typed manuscript. Do not put your name on the manuscript—all submissions are reviewed anonymously. Include a cover letter indicating your name, address, title(s), and category to which you are submitting your work (e.g., fiction, essay, criticism). Prose manuscripts should not far exceed twenty pages. For poetry, submit no more than eight poems. Questions regarding form, particularly for nonfiction prose, may be resolved by consulting *The Chicago Manual of Style*. Requirements for artwork vary—please consult the editors prior to submission. All final publication decisions are made in February. All those submitting are notified then.
