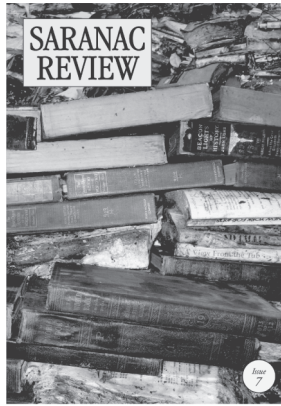


A CLUSTER OF STARS
